ARRIVAL/BOOKING IN PROCEDURES

Go to The Motor Gate at BLOCK C Nooitgedacht – 2 Taylor Street, Stellenbosch where a Head student will meet you on arrival.

FIRST go to The Facility Manager's Office inside the basement to the right of the motor gate to register and once all is found to be in order with your documentation, **you will be directed to The Recreation room where you will receive your Room allocation and Keys. All students in same cluster will be taken up at the same time - Please be patient** and use this time to get to know your fellow residents.

Please make sure you **know who your floor Head Student is, save the contact details on your phone** and enquire from the Head Students on arrival if there are any specific arrangements for the day of your arrival, alternatively you will be free to unpack and settle in.

Ensure that you **meet with your floor's Head student ON THE DAY OF ARRIVAL** to get all information regarding Block C and the registration process at SU.

Save your roommate and other cluster mates contact numbers on your phone and provide your family with one/two of these numbers to contact in event they cannot reach you and need to do so urgently.

For access in and out of the building during the welcoming period, students will be presented with unique tags to access the gates. Please note that students must please **use the pedestrian gate at all times**, the motor gate will only be available for use to students who have vehicles and allocated parking.

COMPULSORY WELCOMING MEETING: 21 JANUARY 2020 @ 18H00:

All first year students have to attend. This will be an informal meeting regarding upcoming PSO and Block C events for the week and registration processes, as well as be an opportunity for the students to familiarise themselves with the HK team, the building and other first years.

DIRECTIONS TO BLOCK C - Nooitgedacht

1. FROM N2 /SOUTHERN SUBURBS

- Take Baden Powell Turn Off towards Stellenbosch
- Continue straight until you get to a T-Junction and turn Right here onto Adam Tas
- Stay on Adam Tas and stay in left lane where it forks at the robot at the station (on your left).
Pass the rugby/sports field on your Right continue and follow Adam Tas until the robot where Adam Tas crosses Bird Street (Mercedes Garage is on your Left and Toyota Garage on your Right)
- Turn Right at this robot onto Bird Street
- Then First Left onto Mount Albert Street (Hyundai on your left)
- Then First Left onto Taylor Street
- BLOCK C Nooitgedacht is the Last block on your Right

2. FROM N1

- Take Stellenbosch Turn off, this becomes Bird Street
- Continue straight up to Robot where Bird Street crosses Adam Tas Street (Mercedes Garage and Toyota Garage on your Right).
- Continue straight over this Robot onto Bird Street
- Turn First Left onto Mount Albert Street
- Then First Left onto Taylor Street
- BLOCK C Nooitgedacht is the Last block on your Right
